The Whaling Museum's **Gosnell Hall** is the ideal setting for an intimate reception, seated dinner, corporate presentation, or for dancing the night away. Adorned by a massive forty-seven foot sperm-whale skeleton, elegant art, priceless artifacts, and equipped with state-of-the-art sound, lighting, and video systems, it is perfect for presentations, slide shows, film screenings, and concerts. Gosnell Hall is a dynamic space your guests will never forget.



The historic 1847 **Hadwen & Barney Candle Factory**, a restored three-story exposed brick space, is an extraordinary venue for hosting a cocktail reception or seated dinner.



There is no better view in Nantucket than from high atop the Whaling Museum on our **Rooftop Observation Deck**. Enjoy dinner, cocktails or small ceremonies with a never-ending panorama in the heart of Nantucket.

The **Discovery Room** is ideal for professional meetings, lectures, and celebrations.

Entrance from the sidewalk allows direct access to the space, which is easily converted into a professional meeting room for seminars and luncheons with its built-in projection and audio systems. It is also available for children's birthday parties.



The 1838 **Quaker Meeting House** on Fair Street is a simple, rustic structure and provides a beautiful and intimate setting for weddings of up to ninety guests.



The **Hadwen House garden** at 96 Main Street, as well as other NHA properties, are available for a limited number of small, elegant receptions, reminiscent of Nantucket's gracious past.
